Century Sunshine Announces to Expand Fertiliser Production Capacity in Ruichang City, Jiangxi Province

(Hong Kong, 24 July 2015) **Century Sunshine Group Holdings Limited** (Stock code: 509.HK, the “Company”, together with its subsidiaries, collectively referred to as the “Group”), today is delighted to announce it entered into an agreement with the People’s Government of Ruichang City, Jiangxi Province, in relation to the acquisition of land use rights of a land parcel with a site area of approximately 800 mu located at Chemical Industrial Park, Matou Town, Ruichang City. The land parcel will be used for the establishment of fertiliser production facilities with a capacity of 1,400,000 tonnes, a self-owned cargo-handling terminal and its auxiliary facilities, to further expand the production scale of the Group’s ecological fertiliser business.

Ruichang City, adjacent to three major coastal economic zones, namely Yangtze River Delta, Pearl River Delta and Southeastern part of Fujian, is a key industrial city of Jiangxi Province. Ruichang City locates along the southern coast of Yangtze River, and its railway network connects two main routes including the Beijing — Kowloon Railway and the Beijing — Guangzhou Railway, which makes it easily accessible by means of water and land transportation. Leveraging on the transportation advantages of Ruichang City, the Group could significantly reduce transportation costs of raw materials and products while substantially improve its operation efficiency. Therefore the new fertiliser production base to be established in the city creates new momentum for long-term and rapid developments of the business of the Group. Furthermore, Ruichang City locates along the coastal areas and is adjacent to the central plains of the PRC, such distinctive geographic advantages could enhance the capability of expanding the sales coverage by the Group, and the market penetration of the Group’s products.

The construction of the expansion project will be split into two phases. The first phase is intended to set up fertiliser production facilities with an annual capacity of 800,000 tonnes and is scheduled to be completed within 3 years; the second phase is intended to expand the fertiliser production facilities with an annual capacity of 600,000 tonnes and is scheduled to be completed within 2 years. The main types of the products to be manufactured by these new fertiliser facilities, with a production capacity of 1,400,000 tonnes fertiliser, include new fertilisers such as silicon magnesium compound fertilisers and fully water soluble fertilisers.

Mr Chi Wen Fu, Chairman and CEO of the Group said, “Given the opportunities arising from the rapid development of new agricultural model lead by the PRC government, the Group has been striving to expanding production capacity and developing new technology, research and innovation, with the aim of becoming one of the leading players of both core businesses in the coming years. The Group has made a step forward to becoming one of the major fertiliser corporations in the PRC with the expansion plan, and the project’s successful completion will also lay a solid foundation for sustainable growth in the Group’s profitability.”
